

Minutes of the Iowa County Airport Commission Meeting April 25, 2005.

1. Called to order by Larry Steffes at 6:01 PM at the Iowa County Courthouse.
2. Roll Call –Those present; Mark Masters, Eric Anderson, Arnie Christen, Larry Steffes, Clinton Fruit, and David Meudt. Steve Foye was excused. Scott Godfrey and Paul Ohlrogge attended along with several members from the public.
3. Certification of open meeting law – Motion made by Anderson, second by Meudt and approved.
4. Approval of January 17, 2005 minutes – Motion by Anderson, second by Christen and approved.
5. Meeting agenda approval – Chairman Steffes requested that approval of the agenda include an agenda item addition between 5 and 6 referring to an update from the public concerning acrobatic flying and a horse rider incident possibly related to noise associated with acrobatic flying. Motion made to accept the addition to the agenda by Masters, seconded by Meudt and approved.
- 5.5 Input was heard from the public regarding a horse rider incident and associated noise from acrobatic flying. Comments were heard from the public and Commission members asked questions pertaining to the incident. The incident occurred on April 21, 2005. Chairman Steffes thanked the public members for bringing it to the attention of the Commission. Mr. John Dorsey of the Bureau of Aeronautics also added comments pertaining to the acrobatic flying near the Airport. Follow up will be given at the next Commission meeting.
6. Land Use Plan Discussion – Scott Godfrey and Paul Ohlrogge facilitated discussion with the Commission and the public regarding a land use plan. No action taken.
7. Hangar lease - Manger King asked for comments concerning hangar leases. He stated that there are four people interested in leasing hangar space. King commented that some existing hangars are not housing aircraft. King will refer possible new renters to the current owners. Also, discussion was held concerning review of future leases.
8. Hangar construction, discussion and possible action – King updated the Commission on the proposed bathroom, taxiway, and hangar construction possibilities. Guidance was given to King regarding review of possible options with the Bureau. King will continue to update the Commission regarding the best options after consultation with the Bureau and architects. Most felt that due to the shortage of hangars and the availability of funds from the Bureau it might be best to proceed with hangar and taxi way construction before updating the current bathrooms. King will report back to the Commission at the next meeting.
9. Mangers report – Written report will be given at the next Commission meeting.

10. Review bills and vouchers. – Anderson moved for approval of bills, seconded by Fruit and approved.

11. Adjournment – Motion by Anderson, seconded by Fruit and approved. Next meeting will be May 23, 2005 at 6 PM at the Iowa County Court House.
