

**Minutes of the Iowa County Airport Commission**  
**April 13, 2010**

1. Chairman Larry Steffes called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM at the Iowa County Airport.
2. Roll Call – Present were Larry Steffes, Arnie Christen, Clinton Fruit, Ronald Berg and Bob Bunker. Eric Anderson was excused and Phil Mrozinski was absent.

No others were present.

3. Certification of Open Meeting Law – Motion by Bob Bunker and seconded by Ron Berg that the meeting was legally posted. Unanimously approved.
4. Motion by Bob Bunker and seconded by Arnie Christen to approve the minutes of the December 14, 2009 meeting. Unanimously approved.
5. Motion by Ronald Berg and seconded by Arnie Christen to approve the April 13, 2010 agenda. Unanimously approved.
6. There were no rezone requests and no action was taken.
7. Airport Manager, Kevin King, informed the Airport Commission of required updates to the fuel systems at the airport. He also informed the Commission of the required timetable for those updates. A motion was made by Ronald Berg and seconded by Bob Bunker to install the required fill tubes for the fuel systems and for Kevin King to obtain prices for the rest of the required fuel system updates. Unanimously approved.
8. The Airport Layout Plan was discussed. No action was taken.
9. Kevin King reviewed the Airport Six Year Plan with the Airport Commission. After a discussion, a motion was made by Ronald Berg and seconded by Bob Bunker to approve the Six Year Plan. Unanimously approved.
10. A discussion was held on the need for a generator at the airport. It was agreed that the generator which will be removed from the Iowa County Courthouse would be adequate for the airport. No action was taken.
11. The Commission discussed the annual Fly In/Drive In Breakfast scheduled for Father's Day, June 20th, 2010. Airport Manager, Kevin King, told the Commission a hangar was available in which to hold the breakfast and that Hodan Center had agreed to host the breakfast. A motion was made by Ronald Berg and seconded by Bob Bunker to proceed with the breakfast. Unanimously approved.
12. A motion was made by Ronald Berg and seconded by Bob Bunker to adjourn at 7:05 pm. Unanimously approved.

No date was set for the next meeting.
