

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE JUNE SESSION  
OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS  
OF IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
June 21, 2005**

The Board of Supervisors met in June Session at the Richard M. Scullion Administrative Annex in the City of Dodgeville on Tuesday, June 21, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. and was called to order by the Honorable Robert Regan, Chairman of the Board.

Roll call was taken. All members were present except Sups. McGuire and Clifton who were excused and Sup. Berg who was absent.

Certification of the County Clerk stating notice that this meeting had been publicly posted and reported to the press and radio station as required by law was read.

Sup. Laufenberg moved to approve the certification.

Sup. Meudt seconded the motion. Carried.

The Board, in unison, led the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the May 17, 2005 meeting were presented.

Sup. E. Anderson moved to approve the minutes.

Sup. Masters seconded the motion. Carried.

The agenda for this June 21, 2005 Session of the Board was presented.

Sup. Foye moved to approve the agenda as presented.

Sup. Ehr seconded the motion. Carried.

The following special matters and announcements were presented to the Board.

1. Mrs. Alice Griffiths, representing the Iowa County Historical Society, invited the Board to tour the Historical Society on July 19<sup>th</sup> before the start of the Board meeting. She informed the Board the Society is in the process of raising funds so a much needed addition can be added to the building.
2. The Mutual Effort.
3. Iowa County Comprehensive Plan.
4. Wisconsin Counties Annual Convention.

Marian Maciej-Hine, Board member of the Community Leadership Alliance, gave a brief overview on what the Alliance is and what its goals are. Marian also informed the Board that UW Extension Community Resource Agent Paul Ohlrogge is the Chairman of the Alliance Board for 2005. She thanked the Board for the support given to the Community Leadership Alliance. Sup. Peterson has gone through the program and recommended it to anyone who may be interested.

Department of Social Services Director Mike Tiber gave a brief history of programs and an overview of the Social Services Department.

Motion to introduce Highway Access Ordinance No. 800.02 and hold over for action until the July Session of the Board was acted on.

Sup. Peterson moved to approve the motion.

Sup. E. Anderson seconded the motion. Carried.

Airport Commission Chairman Larry Steffes read a statement to the Board. He stated that he felt Airport Manager Kevin King has been doing an outstanding job as manager. The airport is faced with many different projects and issues. Two of the more important ones are the aerobatic flight restriction plan and the zoning plan for land use around the airport. On another point, Sup. Steffes stated to the Board that he feels the reporter that has been covering the Airport Commission meetings has been biased in the reporting of the meetings. As Chairman of the Airport Commission, Sup. Steffes wanted to go on record as saying he will ask the media to replace this reporter with an [unbiased] professional reporter.

Airport Manager Kevin King passed around a handout about the airport. He then gave an overview of airport operations and answered questions asked by members of the Board.

Chairman Regan asked the Board to give him names of people who would want to serve on the Iowa County Board of Adjustment. He would like the names before the next Session of the Board.

Chairman Regan also asked for names of people who would like to serve as alternates to the Iowa County Board of Adjustment.

Motion to lease an additional 20 acres of pasture land at the Iowa County Farm to Michael Mueller through October 31, 2005 was acted on.

Sup. Wunderlin moved to approve the motion.

Sup. C. Anderson seconded the motion. Carried.

One motion was made to adopt the following six Amendatory Ordinances.

Sup. Meudt moved to adopt Amendatory Ordinance numbers 1-0605, 2-0605, 3-0605, 4-0605, 5-0605 and 6-0605.

Sup. Foye seconded the motion. Carried.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 1-0605 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential for the purpose of creating three residential lots containing approximately 20.442, 31.433 and 10.394 acres in the Town of Brigham was presented and adopted.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 2-0605 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential for the purpose of creating a residential lot containing approximately 1.45 acres in the Town of Dodgeville was presented and adopted.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 3-0605 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential for the purpose of creating a residential lot containing approximately 7.323 acres in the Town of Pulaski was presented and adopted.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 4-0605 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential for the purpose of creating a residential lot containing approximately 7.5 acres in the Town of Pulaski was presented and adopted.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 5-0605 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural & AR-1 Agricultural Residential to all AR-1 Agricultural Residential for the purpose of creating a residential lot containing approximately 12 acres in the Town of Ridgeway was presented and adopted.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 6-0605 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural to AR-1 Agricultural Residential for the purpose of creating a residential lot containing approximately 29.4 acres in the Town of Waldwick was presented and adopted.
