

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MARCH SESSION  
OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS  
OF IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
March 21, 2006**

The Board of Supervisors met in March Session at the Richard M. Scullion Administrative Annex in the City of Dodgeville on Tuesday, March 21, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. and was called to order by the Honorable Robert Regan, Chairman of the Board.

Roll call was taken. All members were present except Supervisor Thomas who was excused and Sup. Roberts who arrived after roll call.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 6-0306 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural and B-4 Industrial to all B-4 Industrial for the purpose of creating an industrial lot containing approximately 78.42 acres in the Town of Dodgeville was presented and adopted.

Amendatory Ordinance No. 7-0306 for a land use change from A-1 Agricultural to C-1 Conservancy for the purpose of creating a conservancy lot containing approximately 22.4 acres in the Town of Pulaski was presented and adopted.

UW-Extension Department Head Deb Ivey came before the Board to name the 4-H Key Award recipients. They are Krista Lauffer, Stacey Ley, Jillian Weier and Megan Stanek. Krista Lauffer and Megan Stanek were present and told the Board some of the things they have done in 4-H. Stacey Ley and Jillian Weier were unable to attend due to prior commitments.

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 1-0306 Authorizing Participation in the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources County Fish and Game Program was acted on.

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 2-0306 Transfer of Funds from the Contingency Budget to the County Wide Management Training Budget was acted on.

Sup. Perry moved to adopt the resolution.

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 3-0306 Time Sheet Recording Policy to be Applied to all Iowa County Employees was acted on.

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 4-0306 Supporting Funding of the USDA/NRCS 2007 Watershed Program was acted on.

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 5-0306 Adopting a Citizen Participation Plan.

Sup. Peterson moved to adopt the resolution.

Motion to approve the Deed for Street Purposes between Iowa County and the Village of Highland was acted on.

Sup. Wunderlin moved to approve the motion.

Sup. Masters seconded the motion.

Sup. Foye moved to amend the Deed to state that Iowa County is transferring ownership of the land to the Village of Highland and to include an easement to Iowa County.

Sup. C. Anderson seconded the motion. Carried.

The amended motion carried on a voice vote.

The Board debated how many days before the regular Session of the Board meeting the agenda should be posted and mailed.

Sup. Ehr moved to have the agenda mailed and posted on the second Thursday preceding the regular Session of the Board.

County Administrative Study Committee Chairman Dana Perry gave the Board an update as to what the committee has been focusing on to date. He also stated the committee would be giving an in depth report to the Board at the May Session of the Board.
