

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE JULY SESSION
OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS
OF IOWA COUNTY, WISCONSIN
July 20, 2010**

The Board of Supervisors met in the Richard M. Scullion Administrative Annex in the City of Dodgeville on Tuesday, July 20, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. and was called to order by the Honorable David J. Bauer, Chairman of the Board.

Roll call was taken. All members were present except Sups. Carol Anderson, Ronald Benish and Robert Zinck who were excused.

Motion to approve the appointment of Sup. William Grover to the Iowa County Area Economic Development Corporation was acted on.

Motion to approve the appointment of John Jinkins for a two year term as an at large member of the Bloomfield Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center Committee was acted on.

Sup. Pilling moved to approve the motion.

Chairman Bauer granted Sup. Griffiths time for a point of personal privilege.

Chairman David Bauer gave a report to the Board.
