#7	Chair Anderson instructed the Committee to review the Budget reports found on the County Website home page under 2011 Budget and a hard copy of the Oneida report will be provided to committee members for the next meeting. #8	The Sheriff reported that CBM foods have delayed implementation of the food service agreement for the Jail until July 13 <sup>th</sup> in order to get additional supplies ready.	Jail Food Service
