

Iowa County Justice Committee Meeting Tuesday, February 5, 2013 @ 6:00p.m.

Minutes

The Iowa County Justice Committee convened on Tuesday, February 5, 2013 @ 6:00p.m. At the Iowa County Courthouse, in the 2nd floor conference room.

Roll Call: All members were present, with Dave Bauer and Greg Parman excused. Others present: Curt Kephart, Steve Deal, Cheri Philmore, Jan Tabor, Sheriff Steve Michek, and Chief Deputy Jon Pepper.

Consent Agenda:

- a) Approve the February 5, 2013 meeting agenda.
- b) Approve the December 4, 2012 meeting minutes.

Mrozinski made motion to approve. Seconded by Weaver. Carried.

Open Session: Comments from the Audience/Committee members:

- 1) Nankee asked about the County MTO/PTO policy.
- 2) C. Anderson commented on the recent letter sent to all county board supervisors from Sheriff Michek, and stated the issue will be taken up at the next Administrative Services Committee meeting in closed session.
