3	Approve the agenda for the Sept 2nd meeting. Sup. Bomkamp moved to approve the agenda for the meeting. Sup. DeLain seconded the motion. Carried.
4	Approve the minutes of the August 5 <sup>th</sup> meeting. Sup. Bunker moved to approve the minutes of the meeting. Sup. Clerkin seconded the motion. Carried.
5	Comments or reports from the audience or committee members. Excellent comments on the Iowa County Brochure. Justice Dept. representatives, Sheriff and D.A. participated in the ice bucket challenge for ALS.
6	Agenda item. 2014 Revenue & Expenditure Budget Show discussion or motions. Discussion on the Coroner's Budget.
7	Agenda item. Discussion on the full-time position for the Assistant District Attorney. Deadline to apply was September 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2014. County will know by July 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2015 if the position is accepted by the state. Effective date, if approved, will be October 4 <sup>th</sup> , 2015.
8	Agenda item: 2015 Budget. Discussion on the departments that have not completed their budget. OWI Dept. Head, Susan Hepler reported on their budget assisted by Elizabeth Booth with the DOT appropriating \$5 to \$10,000 decrease. Admin Kephart reported that he is still working on the county budget.
9	Agenda item: Corporate Counsel. Matt Allen reported on ATTIC Correctional Services Coordination.
10	Emergency Management: Keith Hurlbert reported on ICEM activities. (1) Municipalities are moving forward on tornado damage with Wis. Disaster Fund Applications. (2) The emergency response plans are being completed/worked on at Village of Ridgeway and Town of Dodgeville. (3) Sheriff's Office Telephone system was hit by lightning – estimated repair of \$50,000. (4) The Next Generation 911 was tested on a cell phone for the deaf and hard of hearing. Some new phones work.
11	Sheriff's Department – Chief Dep. Bryon Bilse gave the employment report interviewing in Sept for Jail Administrator. Full Time Patrol Officer hired in August. Department personnel was promoted to detective. Radio cost could affect next year's budget.
