**ORDINANCE TO  
INCREASE THE  
SIZE OF THE DEPARTMENT  
OF SOCIAL SERVICES  
COMMITTEE**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF IOWA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Social Services is currently composed of three (3) members of the Iowa County Board;

WHEREAS, the Rules for the Government of the Iowa County Board allow each committee to be composed of five (5) members of the Iowa County Board;

WHEREAS, all other committees of the Iowa County Board are composed of five (5) members of the Iowa County Board;

WHEREAS, the State Department of Health and Social Services Division of County Services conducted a Performance Review of the Iowa County Department of Social Services and specifically recommended an increase in the size of the Iowa County Social Services Committee;

WHEREAS, the size of the operating budget and the services that are provided by the Iowa County Department of Social Services are such as to warrant an increase in the size of the Iowa County Social Services Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF IOWA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the size of the Iowa County Committee on Social Services be increased from three (3) to five (5) members and that two (2) additional county board supervisors be elected immediately to serve on said committee.

The County Board of Supervisors of Iowa County does ordain as follows:

- 1.(a)The Iowa County Department of Social Services is hereby designated to participate in the emergency government plan as organized by the County Coordinator and shall for such purposes have the authority to participate in any emergency government activity, whether it be in a case of attack, emergency, Federal/State/County alert or practice or test run,  
and,
  - (b)The duties of said Agency shall include planning and arranging for the welfare and care of residents of this County, as stated in their Emergency Social Services Plan for Annex F, or of other counties of the State who may be evacuated through or into this county or by assisting neighboring Counties as needed,  
and,
  - (c)The Agency, in performance of emergency government activities, may employ additional staff, either full or part time. Such staff shall be employed under the merit system classification and salary range, pursuant to Section 49.02(2) to (5), Wis. Stats., and Rule PW-PA 10 or applicable Union contract, whichever applies.  
and,
  - (d)The County Agency, in the performance of emergency government activities, may make use of volunteer workers who shall receive no salary, but who may be paid necessary and usual out-of-pocket expenses incurred in performing this work; such payment to be made from the Administrative Account of said Agency.
2. The said County Department of Social Services shall cooperate with the State Department of Health and Social Services in any activities or duties carried on by said State Department under Administrative Directive 38 (1-5-1983), or such other responsibilities as may be delegated or provided by law.

WHEREAS, Section 46.22 Wis. Stats., establishes a county department of public welfare and requires that each department shall consist of a county board of public welfare, a county director of public welfare, and necessary personnel, and

WHEREAS, such county department of public welfare has mandatory functions, duties and powers as specified in Section 46.22 Wis. Stats. and other State Statutes, Administrative rules and other State and Federal regulations,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that there shall be a County Board of Social Services which shall consist of three (3) residents of Iowa County. The members of this Board shall be elected by the County Board of Supervisors from its own body, one from a City, one from a Village and one from a Township. The members of the Board of Social Services shall hold office for a term of one year and they shall be compensated for per diem and mileage, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Iowa County Department of Social Services shall have the functions, duties and powers in accordance with Section 46.22 Wis. Stats. and other State Statutes, Administrative rules and other State and Federal regulations, that relate to the functions, duties and powers of the Department and in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the State Department of Health and Social Services and be subject to the supervision of the State Department of Health and Social Services. (see Ordinance regarding participation in emergency government programs) and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

(1) The official name of the county department of public welfare shall be "Iowa County Department of Social Services".

(2) Any provision of any prior ordinance, resolution or action of the Iowa County Board of Supervisors in conflict with any provision of this ordinance shall be superseded by this ordinance.

(3) Such merit system status as the County Director of Social Services or any employees of the Iowa County Department of Social Services may have on the effective date of this ordinance shall not be deemed changed or interrupted by the provisions of this ordinance.
