

**ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE SALE OR GIFT OF CIGARETTES OR  
TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18**

DEFINITIONS:

"Cigarette" means any roll of tobacco wrapped in paper or any substance other than tobacco.

"Tobacco Products" means cigars; cheroots; stogies; periques; granulated, plug cut, crimp cut, ready-rubbed and other smoking tobacco; snuff; snuff flour; Cavendish; plug and twist tobacco; fine cut and other chewing tobaccos; shorts; refuse scraps; chippings; cuttings; and sweepings of tobacco and other kinds and forms of tobacco prepared in such manner as to be suitable for chewing or smoking in a pipe or otherwise, or both for chewing and smoking.

RESTRICTIONS:


No retailer, manufacturer, distributor, jobber or sub-jobber, no agent, employee or independent contractor of a retailer, manufacturer, distributor, jobber or sub-jobber and no agent or employee of an independent contractor may sell or provide for nominal or no consideration cigarettes or tobacco products to any person under the age of 18.

PENALTIES:

A person who commits a violation is subject to a forfeiture of:

- a. Not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus Court costs if the person has not committed a previous violation within twelve (12) months of the violation; or
- b. Not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) plus Court costs if the person has committed a previous violation within twelve (12) months of the violation.




