RESOLUTION EXPRESSING DEEP CONCERN REGARDING PLANS
BY GREYHOUND BUS LINES TO DISCONTINUE SERVICE ON THE
MADISON TO DUBUQUE ROUTE

WHEREAS, it has come to our attention that the Greyhound Bus Lines has given notice that the Madison, Wisconsin to Dubuque, Iowa, bus route was discontinued on April 7, 1991; and

WHEREAS, this route currently provides the only bus service to the communities of Dickeyville, Platteville, Belmont, Dodgeville, Mineral Point, Ridgeway, Barneveld, Mount Horeb and Verona; and


WHEREAS, this service is very important to these communities and their residents, especially Platteville, community of approximately 10,000 population and a University with an enrollment of approximately 5,000 students.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, that this Board go on record expressing its deep concern for this loss of transportation service to southwestern Wisconsin; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution should be sent to Greyhound Bus Lines in the hopes that they will reconsider their decision on this issue and maintain this important service and to Governor TOMMY G. THOMPSON; State Senator Richard Kreul; Assemblyman Stephen J. Freese to inform them of our concern and solicit their support.
