RESOLUTION NO. 3

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors has recognized the need for a long-range plan of library service, and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors has appointed a Library Planning Committee to study the library services in Iowa County, and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Library Planning Committee examined existing services, analyzed future needs, solicited citizen input, and held public hearings, and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Library Planning Committee has made recommendations for a long-range library service in Iowa County,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors approves the "Iowa County Long-Range Plan of Library Service 1991-1996," and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors establishes a twelve member standing committee to include:


- an Iowa County Supervisor;
- an Iowa County representative from the Southwest Wisconsin Library System Board of Trustees;
- a librarian or a board member from each of the four public libraries in the county;
- four representatives from areas within the county without direct public library access (one from the four sections of the county as determined by the intersection of Highways 18 and 23); and
- two at large representatives.

The full term of office will be three years with rotation to be determined at the first meeting of the standing committee.
