

RESOLUTION REQUESTING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE  
SOUTHWESTERN WISCONSIN REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION WITH THE  
DEVELOPMENT OF A HIGHWAY PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM  
FOR IOWA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Highway Committee would like to develop a more systematic approach to prioritizing and scheduling highway improvement projects for the county highway system; and

WHEREAS, the Southwestern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission encourages the member counties to develop such highway pavement management systems and would be available to provide technical assistance with this work at no additional cost to the counties; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation also encourages the counties to develop such highway pavement management programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby goes on record to request technical assistance from the Regional Planning Commission with the development of a highway pavement management program for the county highway system in Iowa County.
