

FORMATION OF A RESOURCE
CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS; the Iowa County Land Conservation Committee would like to join with several surrounding counties to form a Resource Conservation and Development Council, RC&D and

WHEREAS; section 66.30 provides counties with the authority to contract to establish an intercounty entity that plans and implements regional projects for natural resources conservation and development, and

WHEREAS; a RC&D is a United States Department of Agriculture cost-sharing program designed to assist communities in accomplishing natural resource and community facilities projects that are not included in other available programs, and

WHEREAS; it is a federal approach viewed by local people as a program because they initiate, direct and control the program, and

WHEREAS; it provides a way for new initiative and cooperative efforts by agricultural, business, and community leaders; environmental, conservation and development groups; and citizens of the area. The project provides the means for these people to direct the activities of federal, state and local governments, therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors directs the Land Conservation Committee to develop a contract with, several other counties to form a Resource Conservation and Development Council, and be it further

RESOLVED that any Land Conservation Committee action to carry out its delegated powers is subject to the approval of the county board, whether the Land Conservation Committee is carrying out a power specifically delegated to it in s.92.07 or a responsibility assigned to it by the county board.
