

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF IOWA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Section 49.02, Wis Statutes, provides that a county is eligible to receive a Relief Block Grant if the County adopts a resolution applying for a grant, establishes written criteria used to determine dependency and reviews the criteria annually and submits a plan to the Department of Health and Family Services, and

WHEREAS, The Iowa County Relief program, as established by Iowa County, has meet the needs of those fond eligible for relief benefits in calendar year 1996, and

WHEREAS, The Iowa County Board of Social Services has reviewed the current program criteria and recommends that Iowa County continue to participate in the General Relief Block Grant program, for calendar year 1997 and that the Iowa County Department of Social Services continue to be designated as the relief agency, now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby applies for a Relief Block Grant for calendar year 1997, and




