


RESOLUTION NO. 2-996

WHEREAS, the State Historical Society has statutory responsibility to collect, maintain and make available for their permanently valuable records of Wisconsin's local governments and court system. Local governments include include municipalities, towns, school districts, counties, and special districts. In general the Society collects local records that document the administration of government, settlement of estates and resolution of family matters, adjudication of disputes, naturalization, education, recording of private property ownership, recording of vital statistics and taxation.

WHEREAS Wisconsin Statutes 19.21 (5xd) and Supreme Court Rule 72.04 require notification to the State Historical Society of Wisconsin sixty days prior to the destruction of obsolete public records. The appropriate officer of a county, municipality, town or school district must notify the State Historical Society in writing at least 60 days prior to destruction.

WHEREAS the Chairman of the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the Iowa County Register of Deeds office, will sign this resolution as the appropriate authorizing officer for Iowa County, and a signed copy of this resolution and attached form will be forwarded to the State Historical Society of Wisconsin.
