

RESOLUTION NO. 96-5-996

A Resolution Authorizing the Negotiation of the Sale of the Machinery and Equipment at the Muscoda Solid Waste Incinerator.

WHEREAS the Muscoda Solid Waste Commission, which owns and supervises the Muscoda Solid Waste Incinerator, desires to sell all of the equipment and salvageable material at the Incinerator so as to recover at least some of the Commission's costs, and

WHEREAS members of the Commission met with Mr. Joseph VanBree, who is the President of J., T. & T., Inc., which is a Racine salvage company, and discussed methods to sell all equipment and salvageable equipment at the Incinerator, and

WHEREAS the Commission now seeks authority to enter into contract negotiations with J., T. & T., Inc., with the proviso that any final agreement must be approved and ratified by the County Boards of the three county members of the Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that approval is hereby granted for the Muscoda Solid Waste Commission to enter into contract negotiations with J., T. & T., Inc., a Racine salvage company, whereby J., T. & T., Inc. will make all reasonable efforts to sell all the equipment and salvageable material at the Incinerator, under terms mutually agreeable by J., T. & T., Inc., and the County Boards of the three county members of the Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event a final agreement is approved and ratified by the County Boards of the three county members of the Commission, the Chair of the Commission is hereby authorized to sign a written contract with J., T. & T., Inc., and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective only upon the adoption of a like Resolution by the County Boards of Richland and Grant Counties.
