

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HISTORICAL SOCIETY BUDGET REQUESTS

RESOLUTION (13-697)

TO THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Joint Finance Committees recommended cuts in the budget of the State Historical Society is of great concern, and

WHEREAS, these budget cuts will potentially bring devastating consequences to the maintenance and operating budgets of the Wisconsin Historical Sites and

WHEREAS, if the new cuts stand, the Historical Sites Program will lose its entire advertising budget just as the State of Wisconsin begins its Sesquicentennial celebration.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT BEST RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors go on record supporting restoration of historic sites appropriation to current levels and restoration of as much of the administration's budget cuts, as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to members of the Joint Finance Committee, our Iowa County representatives and to Governor Thompson.
