STATE SHARED REVENUE

WHEREAS, legislation is being drafted to eliminate State Shared Revenue to Wisconsin municipalities, and

WHEREAS, for 1997, Iowa County will receive approximately \$358,725.00 in Shared Revenue, and

WHEREAS, if Shared Revenue were to be eliminated, Iowa County would have to increase the County share on property taxes by the aforementioned amount of approximately \$358,725.00, and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Legislative Committee does not feel this would be of benefit to the residents of Iowa County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors go on record opposing the Legislation taking any action to remove State Shared Revenue to Wisconsin municipalities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to our Iowa County representatives, the Wisconsin Counties Association and Governor Thompson.
