

**RESOLUTION SETTING THE SALARY OF THE JUDICIAL ASSISTANT/
REGISTER IN PROBATE**

WHEREAS, the governing body of Iowa County may set the hourly work week and salaries for management, non-represented employees;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement and the Committee on Salary and Personnel recognizes the increased duties of the Judicial Assistant/Register in Probate in calendaring the Court's calendar, completing correspondence, keeping abreast of all court cases and assisting the presiding circuit court judge, as well as maintaining the increasing amount of estate, guardianship, mental and juvenile case types;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement and the Committee on Salary and Personnel recommends that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors increase the hourly work week for the Judicial Assistant/Register in Probate from 35 hours per week to 40 hours per week and raise the salary for that position from the position's current 1997 salary of \$22,913.00 to \$25,000.00, and apply a 3% increase to that amount. The total salary for 1998 (which includes the 3% increase) will be \$25,750.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that:


The Iowa County Board of Supervisors adopt the recommendations of the Committee on Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement and the Committee on Salary and Personnel, and approves the increase in the hourly work week of the Judicial Assistant/Register in Probate to 40 hours per week. The Committee(s) also approves increasing the 1998 salary of Judicial Assistant/Register to \$25,000.00, and approves the application of a 3% increase to that \$25,000.00, making the total 1998 salary \$25,750.00.
