

RESOLUTION NO. 5-197  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A STATE GRANT APPLICATION  
FOR A  
WASTE TIRE COLLECTION PROGRAM  
FOR IOWA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Iowa County residents generate a substantial number of waste tires each year and a large number of historical waste tires are stockpiled or illegally disposed of throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, stockpiled and illegally disposed waste tires are not only unsightly, but pose a threat to public health by serving as breeding places for disease carrying mosquitoes and from the dangers created by hard to extinguish fires which emit noxious fumes; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Waste Tire Management or Recovery Grant Program provides cost sharing for the operation of a waste tire collection program; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County intends to conduct a one-time, multi-site waste tire collection program available to all Iowa County residents and \_\_\_\_\_ businesses, including those with large stockpiles of tires; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors authorizes an application for a Waste Tire Management or Recovery Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Iowa County Health Department Director of Nursing, June Meudt, be the authorized representative to act on behalf of the County to submit the grant application, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Iowa County will carry out all proposed activities as described in the grant application and approved for funding by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Iowa County will maintain appropriate records to document expenditures for which cost sharing will be claimed; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources employees will have access to inspect project sites and records upon request during normal business hours.
