

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZATION TO
MAKE APPLICATION FOR PECFA FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Petroleum Environmental Cleanup Fund Act (PECFA) provides funds with a current maximum award of \$1 million with a \$10,000 deductible for cleanup costs associated with petroleum product storage systems such as underground storage tanks;


WHEREAS, there is certain tax delinquent property located within the City of Mineral Point on Highway 151 which has on the premises underground gasoline storage tanks;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Bonds & Insurance desires to return said property to productive use;




