

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, IOWA COUNTY GOVERNMENT provides facilities to Iowa County employees and citizens, which provide them with access to huge amounts of data and information. These facilities represent a considerable commitment of county resources for computing, telecommunications, networking, software, storage, etc., and all these things are regarded as key to county success and productivity. The Iowa County Information Infrastructure can not be compromised, or changed without considering the impact on all who may be dependent upon its integrity and availability.

WHEREAS, the Committee on Information Systems, recognizes the County's significant investment in electronic information infrastructure such as the Mainframe Server, Ethernet, TCP/IP Network Switches, T1, 56K and other telephonic connections, DB2 (Relational Database), and PC standard platforms and software suites, etc. to assist the Iowa County employees in performing their job duties, as well as providing citizens access to pertinent data and information;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Information Systems, has reviewed the need for an establishment of a resolution that protects the significant investment of Iowa County in electronic information infrastructure for both the Iowa County employees and taxpayers and recommends that the following resolution be adopted:


Iowa County resolves that, no changes, modifications, additions or deletions from or to the Iowa County Information Infrastructure will be made without the expressed written approval of Information Systems Committee. Furthermore, that any and all proposed changes, modifications, additions or deletions to the Iowa County Information Infrastructure be submitted to the Director of Information Systems for the purposes of assessment. The Director of Information Systems assessment will include a determination of the need for as well as the impact, both financially and strategically, to the entire Iowa County Information Infrastructure. The Director of Information Systems recommendation will be presented to the Information Systems Committee. The Information Systems Committee will relay their decision to the initiating department.






