

**RESOLUTION SETTING THE HOURS FOR THE COMMISSION ON AGING DIRECTOR**

**TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of Iowa County may set the hourly work week for salaried management/non-represented employees;

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa County Commission on Aging Board recognizes the increased duties of the Commission on Aging (COA) Director and recommends that the hours of work be increased from thirty-five (35) hours per week to forty (40) hours with the usual daily starting time of 8:00a.m. and usual daily ending time of 4:30p.m. with a thirty (30) minutes unpaid lunch.


