

Resolution No. 13-1299

IN FAVOR OF 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 321 RELATING TO PROCEEDS FROM SALES OF TAX DELINQUENT PROPERTY

WHEREAS, when tax delinquent property is sold under current law, delinquent taxes, interest, penalties and special charges against the property are deducted from the sales price and remaining funds are then paid to the former property owner ONLY IF the former owner had used the property as a homestead; and

WHEREAS, if the property were not used as a homestead, the county would retain said funds; and

WHEREAS, 1999 Assembly Bill 321 would mandate payment of remaining funds to the former owner REGARDLESS OF whether or not said property was homestead property; and

WHEREAS, said 1999 Assembly Bill 321, if passed, would provide equal and equitable treatment to both former property owners of homesteads as well as former property owners of businesses and other non-homestead property;

WHEREAS, the Legislative, Resource Development & Tourism Committee has reviewed this issue and recommended that the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Iowa go on record as supporting this legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Iowa does hereby ordain and resolve as follows: That Iowa County supports passage of the 1999 Assembly Bill 321;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of the Resolution be forwarded by the County Clerk to Governor Thompson, the Secretary of Revenue and all State Representatives and State Senators representing Iowa County.
