

**RESOLUTION NO. 5-0500 AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 400.09**

Animal Waste Storage and Nutrient Utilization

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors desire to amend the above entitled ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, The Iowa County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows

Section 1. **AMENDING CODE.** The Animal Waste Storage and Nutrient Utilization Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following language as indicated by underline;

Section 3: **ACTIVITIES SUBJECT TO REGULATION**

3.01 Permit Required:

(3) **FOR CONCRETE FACILITIES**

- b. If found to be structurally sound and not leaking, re-use will be approved.
- c. If found to be structurally unsound or leaking, re-use will be denied.

Section 5: **APPLICATION FOR AND ISSUANCE OF PERMITS**

5.04 Manure storage facility and Nutrient Management Plan Required.

...Plans must be provided on behalf of the landowner by a registered professional engineer or agricultural engineering practitioner....


Section 5: **APPLICATION FOR AND ISSUANCE OF PERMITS**

5.06 Permit Conditions


- (D) After completion of the project, the applicants engineer or agricultural engineering practitioner must submit to the Iowa County Zoning Office a certificate of completion and an as built plan that states all standards and specifications are met for the purpose of applying for a certificate of compliance....

Section 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The herein Ordinance and Amendments shall take effect upon adoption and posting.


