

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A SMALL BUSINESS LOAN
FROM THE
IOWA COUNTY REVOLVING LOAN FUND
(Application No. 22-5/00)

WHEREAS, **Billy J. and Patti L. Lawinger III and Gary J. and Laura M. Jenkins d/b/a Lawinger & Jenkins, LLC.**, located in Mineral Point, proposes a new restaurant within Iowa County, and will construct the facility, to be called **Billy's Roaring 20's Speakeasy and Steakhouse**, at Mineral Point; and


WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Finance, Bonds and Insurance, acting as the Iowa County Loan Review Committee, has received a request from the small business concern for **\$60,000** to be matched with approximately **\$521,500** in private funds and **\$50,000** in Mineral Point RLF funds, for the purposes of improvements to real estate located at 1050 Branger Road (near U.S. Highway 151 North, Mineral Point), the purchase of equipment and furnishings, and the purchase of inventory; and


WHEREAS, the Committee finds that the project is consistent with the conditions set forth in the Iowa County Loan Administration Manual; and


WHEREAS, the benefits to be derived and the terms agreed upon as set forth in the attached Project Summary are satisfactory.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Loan Review Committee recommends that the proposed project be approved by the full County Board.
