

**RESOLUTION NO. 9-1200**

**DIRECTOR OF PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT**

**TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

**WHEREAS**, there is presently a position of full-time salaried Zoning Administrator within the Management and Non-Represented staff that now includes the duties and responsibilities of a Director of Planning and Development;

**WHEREAS**, said Zoning Administrator position is currently located within the Iowa County Office of Planning and Development and works at the jurisdictional oversight of the Committee on Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission;

**WHEREAS**, this position provides extensive and specialized assistance to the Committee on Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission to develop, coordinate, geographic information systems, and land records modernization functions, and to plan, direct and supervise the Iowa County Office of Planning and Development staff and activities including county land use and sanitary permitting process, code enforcement, fire sign and mapping programs, Board of Adjustment staffing and current/projected land use planning. In addition, this Director position serves as Land Information Officer and County Liaison to WI Land Information Board;

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of a Director of Planning and Development would not create a new position nor change the position's direct working relationship with the Iowa County Committee on Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission but would only reflect the true level of duties and responsibilities that are to be performed;


**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Salary and Personnel, supports the recommendation of the Committee on Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission that said Zoning Administrator position be re-titled to Director of Planning and Development effective January 1, 2001;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS** that the full-time salaried position of Director of Planning and Development be established to supervise and direct the activities of the Iowa County Office of Planning and Development. That said position with its duties and responsibilities has been evaluated as part of the management/non-represented compensation study completed by Carlson, Dettmann and Associates and placed in Grade H with an annual salary of \$42,140.80;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the salary and fringe benefit allocation continue to come from the Iowa County Office of Planning and Development;
