**Resolution to Hire Part-Time Public Health Nurse**

WHEREAS, the Public Health Department has seen an increase in its program use, Jail Health, Maternal Child Health (MCH), Environmental Health, to name a few;

WHEREAS, the role of the Public Health Department is being looked at and redefined by a state effort called "Turning Point" as well as by the current situation in the country;


WHEREAS, it is important to have a public health nurse available daily;

WHEREAS, revenues in certain programs will increase next year and help cover the cost of a part-time public health nurse.

BE IT RESOLVED that we recommend the public health nurse staffing positions to increase to three with one full-time (35 hours), one part-time (28 hours) and one at two days/week.

Voted and passed on November 1, 2001 by the Health Committee.




