**RESOLUTION TO MODIFY THE SALARY GRADE FOR THE PERSONNEL/FINANCE  
CONFIDENTIAL ADMINISTRATIVE SECRETARY**

**TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

**WHEREAS**, the governing body of Iowa County may set the salary/wage for management/non-represented employees;

**WHEREAS**, the Personnel/Finance Confidential Administrative Secretary position was included in the compensation study conducted by Carlson Dettmann Associates in 2000 and placed in salary grade B at \$11.40/hour effective January 1, 2001;

**WHEREAS**, all management/non-represented positions had the option to appeal the salary grade placement of their positions to Carlson Dettmann Associates. Charles Carlson reviewed all appeals and forwarded his final recommendations to the Committee on Salary and Personnel;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Salary and Personnel has reviewed each individual appeal recommendation received from Carlson and brings to the County Board of Supervisors for their adoption the recommended change in salary grade placement for the Personnel/Finance Confidential Administrative Secretary;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Salary and Personnel recommends that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors place the Personnel/Finance Confidential Administrative Secretary in salary grade C at \$11.57/hour effective January 1, 2001;


**BE IT RESOLVED**, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors adopt the recommendation of the Committee on Salary and Personnel, and approve the placement in salary grade C at \$11.57/hour for the Personnel/Finance Confidential Administrative Secretary effective January 1, 2001.
