

RESOLUTION NO. 3-0401

Geographical Information Systems Coordinator

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, presently there is a need in the Office of Planning and Development to establish a new full-time (i.e., 40hrs/wk) salaried Geographical Information Systems (GIS) Coordinator position within the management and non-represented staff that includes the duties and responsibilities listed in the attached four (4)-page job description;

WHEREAS, the GIS Coordinator will report to the Director of the Office of Planning and Development and will supervise the Land Records Division staff. In addition to staff supervision the GIS Coordinator will oversee and coordinate the technical management and administration of the Land Records geospatial information technology and information systems;

WHEREAS, said governing Committee on Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission has established the need for the additional highly-skilled position and has reflected the wages and benefit allocation for the GIS Coordinator in the Office of Planning and Development 2001 Departmental budget;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel, supports the recommendation of the Committee on Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission that said GIS Coordinator position be established effective May 1, 2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that the full-time salaried position of GIS Coordinator be established to supervise and direct the activities of the Land Records Division. That said position with its duties and responsibilities has been evaluated as part of the management/non-represented compensation study completed by Carlson, Dettmann and Associates and placed in Grade G with an annual salary range of \$33,342.40 – \$39,062.40 commensurate with education and experience;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the salary and fringe benefit allocation continue to come from the Iowa County Office of Planning and Development's budget;






