

Resolution Number: 3-1001

WHEREAS the State of Wisconsin has enacted legislation mandating that local governmental units that engage in land use decisions after January 1, 2010 must have enacted a Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS Iowa County also engages in land use decisions and will remain to do so after January 1, 2010; thus Iowa County, with the assistance of the Southwest Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, is proceeding with the development of a Comprehensive Plan and will be seeking grant money to help fund that effort, and

WHEREAS Intergovernmental Cooperation is one of nine required elements of a Comprehensive Plan required by state law, and

WHEREAS a majority of communities in Iowa County has made a commitment to partner with Iowa County in seeking state grant money to be used toward creating Comprehensive Plans, and


WHEREAS the Southwest Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission has determined a cost to Iowa County for the creation of a Comprehensive Plan to be \$135,000, which can be spread out over a three (3) year period,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Iowa County Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission recommends to the Iowa County Board of Supervisors to appoint the Southwest Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission to create a Comprehensive Plan that complies with statute for Iowa County.


This Resolution was adopted by the Iowa County Zoning, Planning, Sanitation and Rural Planning Commission on September 25, 2001.
