WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel can exercise all management functions to include the creation and hiring of represented employees within the provisions of the contract;


WHEREAS, the Committee on Courts, Justice, and Law Enforcement has recommended the creation of a full-time (40hrs/wk) Investigator position to deal with the increased job duties as related to law enforcement matters;


WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel supports the recommendation of the Committee on Courts, Justice, and Law Enforcement to create a full-time Investigator position to cover the increased duties as related to law enforcement matters;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the additional full-time Investigator position be created as based on the work load and need. Furthermore that the position be covered under the conditions, terms, and provisions of all the applicable contract sections of the Wisconsin Profession Police Association Law Enforcement Employees Relations Division (WPPA/LEER).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Iowa County Board of Supervisors adopt the recommendation of the Committee on Salary and Personnel, and approve the creation of an Investigator position effective January 17, 2001. In addition, that all wages and applicable benefits for the position come out of the Sheriff's Department budget;
