

**Establishing Per Diem Compensation
for the
Court Security Officer**

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Security and Facility Committee and Circuit Court Judge William Dyke recommend establishing a part-time position titled Court Security Officer to conform with Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 59 and the Wisconsin Statutes Supreme Court Rules 70.39 to be present while Courts are in session to increase security;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel supports the above recommendation with the establishment of the part-time Court Security Officer position effective April 20, 2001;

WHEREAS, Committee on Salary and Personnel further recommends that the compensation for the part-time Court Security Officer for a scheduled court date be set as a per diem with IRS mileage reimbursement;

WHEREAS, for a scheduled court day the part-time Court Security Officer's daily per diem will be \$50.00 per day with mileage reimbursed at the current year's IRS rate for the performance of duties (see attached job description);

WHEREAS, when a scheduled court day becomes a "report day" (i.e., the Court Security Officer's services are cancelled) the per diem shall be reduced to \$15.00 for that "report day" with mileage reimbursed at the current year's IRS rate;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the per diem compensation and mileage be paid to the part-time Court Security Officer and that the per diem and mileage come from the Circuit Courts' budget effective April 20, 2001.


