

RESOLUTION NO. 4-0901

**AMENDING THE IOWA COUNTY SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION
STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE FARMLAND PRESERVATION
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection has authorized county staff to work on other conservation programs that they are developing.

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Land Conservation Office is committed to meeting the workload challenge that will result from those developing programs.

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Land Conservation Committee would have flexibility in determining that workload.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it recommended by the Iowa County Land Conservation Committee that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors adopt this resolution.

Section 1. **AMENDING STANDARDS.** The Iowa County Soil and Water Conservation standards are hereby amended by striking the existing language and replacing with proposed language that is indicated by the underline;

2. **Spot-Checking**

a. **Frequency**

1. Strike existing language, "All participants shall be spot-checked once every four (4) years."
1. Replace with proposed language, "All participants shall be spot-checked based on the Iowa County Land Conservation Office's workload to be determined by the Iowa County Land Conservation Committee (LCC)."

Section 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The herein Ordinance and Amendments shall take effect upon adoption and posting.
