**Whereas**, it is the intent of Iowa County to respect an individual's right to protect sensitive data while simultaneously providing commonly sought after data to be available;



## Geographic information System Website Intranet Privacy Policy

It is the intent of Iowa County Government to provide access to public records while protecting the privacy interests of citizens in the community. This policy shall pertain to the County internal network system (Intranet) only.

Iowa County will provide certain public records in an electronic format via the Intranet, as a service to County departments and client access terminals within the Iowa County government offices. Names of property owners shall be available on the departmental view of the parcel information on the Intranet. The client access viewing located on the public access terminals shall withhold owner names. In compliance with open records laws, this information may be obtained through the appropriate departments as it has been in the past.


Iowa County recognizes each department's custodianship of information contained in their offices. No department shall, through access to all available information, distribute, manipulate, or copy information for distribution, which is the sole responsibility of other County departments.

It will be presumed all data provided to the Land Records/GIS Office will be available for public access. It is the responsibility for each department to determine what information shall be classified as private and should not be available via the Intranet.

The accuracy of the information contained on the GIS Website is limited to the quality of the data obtained from other public records. The website is not a substitute for an actual field survey, documentation or records held by the County. For inquiries or comments, please contact the appropriate county department.
