WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the scheduled hours of nurses' services in the County's Health Department:

WHEREAS, the Committee has considered the need for the County Health Department to provide an increasing volume of services to County residents:


WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors has approved seventeen (17) additional work hours for Public Health Nurses in the 2002 budget:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, that a new Public Health Nurse position scheduled for 17 hours per week be added to the current Health Department staff of two nurses. Recruitment for this position will commence upon approval of this Resolution.


