

Iowa County Board of Supervisors

Resolution No. 1-0103

Whereas Iowa County has previously taken action to secure and provide for the services of an emergency management director by contract rather than an employee thereby eliminating the cost of fringe benefits providing a substantial saving to the county, and

Whereas the current expenses for the Iowa County emergency management program are one of the lowest cost, if not the least expensive, county programs in the State while providing a workable and responsible effort in security precautions for people and property, and

Whereas it remains in the best interest of Iowa County to continue the current contract it is now reasonable to increase the contract payment to retain or obtain a qualified provider and also be eligible to receive additional State aid, and

Whereas the budget as approved for 2003 has provided adequate funds to allow this proposal and action

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the contract allowance for the Iowa County Emergency Management Director be amended to increase the amount of compensation to provide an annual allowance of sixteen thousand dollars per year effective January 1, 2003, with all other terms of the contract remaining unchanged.
