

RESOLUTION NO. 1 - 0703

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the scheduled hours of Road Patrol Officer services in the Iowa County Sheriff's Department,

WHEREAS, the Committee has considered the need for the Sheriff's Department to provide an increasing volume of road patrol services,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has been awarded a Department of Justice C.O.P.S. grant which will provide funding to offset expenses for two full time Patrol Officer positions for three years as follows: 75% first year, 50% second year, and 25 % third year, with Iowa County funding the corresponding remaining percentages,

WHEREAS, the Committee understands that the grant does not cover overtime pay expenses or expenses related to required equipment purchases,


WHEREAS, the Committee further understands that the Sheriff's Department must continue to fund these positions with County resources for a full budget cycle one year after the grant-funded three years expire,

WHEREAS, the Committee is in agreement with the Iowa County Finance Committee in approving these two full time Road Patrol Officer positions:




