

**RESOLUTION NO. 5-0904**

**TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa County Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the scheduled hours of nurses' services in the County's Health Department:

**WHEREAS**, the Committee has considered the need for the County Health Department to provide services to County residents:

**WHEREAS**, the Salary & Personnel Committee approved an additional 7 hours of Public Health Nurse hours as recently as 2003,

**WHEREAS** the Iowa County Health Committee did not approve a recent request for an additional 17hours/week regular Public Health Nurse position,

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa County Health Committee and Finance Committee did approve the establishment of a Limited Term Nurse pool in August 2004,

**WHEREAS**, the Salary & Personnel Committee believes that a Limited Term Public Health Nurse employee that works less than 600 hours per year may represent a cost-effective means to staff public health assignments on an intermittent basis,


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, that a Limited Term Public Health nurse pool with a starting rate of pay of \$ 21/hour, and maximum total hours set at 40 hours in 2004 and 170 hours in 2005 be added to the Public Health Department,
