

**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF IOWA COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, Section 938.355(6d)1, Wis. Statutes, permits the taking into custody and placement of a juvenile, who has been adjudged delinquent and violates a condition of the dispositional order, in a secure or nonsecure detention facility for up to 72 hours, without a hearing, while the alleged violation is investigated, subject to adopted court policies and county board adopted policies, and

**WHEREAS**, The Iowa County Board has approved such policy on 2/17/98, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 938.355(6d)2, Wis. Statutes, permits the taking in to custody and placement of a juvenile who has been adjudged delinquent and violates a condition of the dispositional order, in a secure or nonsecure detention facility for up to 72 hours, without a hearing, as a consequence of that violation, subject to adopted court policies and county board adopted policies, and

**WHEREAS**, The Iowa County Board has approved such policy on 3/20/01, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 938.34(3)(f) Wis. Statutes permits placement, subject to an adopted county board resolution, of adjudicated juveniles in secure or nonsecure detention facilities, designated by the Court, for a combination of single or consecutive days totaling not more than 30 days, and


**WHEREAS**, The Iowa County Juvenile Court and Department of Social Services finds that this additional dispositional alternatives would enhance the Court's and the Department's ability to manage adjudicated juveniles, now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Social Service and the Juvenile Court to apply the provisions of ss. 398.34(3)(f), when applicable, subject to policies developed by the Juvenile Court and the County Board, and.




