Resolution Recommending Budget Amendments for 2005

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, Social Service was required to upgrade the speed of the DSL line to use the full capacity of the State computer programs and the County programs that are accessed via the DSL line.

WHEREAS, Social Services did not budget for this additional cost.

WHEREAS, Social Services will receive a reimbursement for part of the cost and the Information System Department has agreed to share the remaining cost.


WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Bonds, Insurance, and Tax Claims recommends the following budget amendments to the 2005 accounts as scheduled:




