Resolution Recommending Budget Amendments for 2005

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, Social Service Department purchased nine computers to replace thin-client terminals which do not met the minimum required need to run the State applications.

WHEREAS, Social Services Department has not budgeted for this additional cost.

WHEREAS, Social Services will receive a reimbursement for half of the cost of \$9,226.35 for the nine computers and the Information System Department has agreed to pay \$3,506.58 of the remaining cost.


WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Bonds, Insurance, and Tax Claims recommends the following budget amendments to the 2005 accounts as scheduled:




