Resolution Recommending Budget Amendments for Library Aids for 2005

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, Southwest Public Library Systems contacted the County Clerk explaining that the amount certified for Public Library Aids on the 2004 Tax Roll was incorrect due to the fact that the previous three year average for all libraries was higher than the amount certified for the 2004 tax roll.

WHEREAS, the correct amount was \$125,232.49 which is \$2,844.82 higher than the amount allocated on the 2004 taxes collected in 2005.






NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors that:
