**RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE CLERK OF CIRCUIT COURT  
TO CHARGE AND COLLECT A SERVICE FEE  
FOR ACCEPTING CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS**

**WHEREAS**, Assembly Bill 211, effective April 1, 2006 will produce several statutory changes that affect the collection of fees, fines, forfeitures and surcharges;

**WHEREAS**, a new subsection §59.40(5) Wis. Stats. allows the Clerk of Circuit Court to accept credit or debit cards for any required payment to the clerk;


**WHEREAS**, said subsection additionally allows the clerk to charge and collect a service fee for accepting the credit or debit cards;

**WHEREAS**, the amount of the service fee which is 100% county retained, must be set by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors;


**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement recommends a service fee of five dollars (\$5) for every one-hundred dollars (\$100) charged;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that a service fee of five dollars (\$5) for every one hundred dollars (\$100) be charged on credit or debit cards used.**


