RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE IOWA COUNTY CLERK OF CIRCUIT COURT TO CHARGE A FEE OF FIFTEEN (\$15) FOR ESTABLISHING AND MONITORING A PAYMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 211, effective April 1, 2006 will produce several statutory changes that affect the collection of fees, fines, forfeitures and surcharges;

WHEREAS, a new subsection §59.40(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes allows the Clerk of Circuit Court to charge a fee, not to exceed fifteen dollars (\$15), for establishing and monitoring a payment plan;

WHEREAS, The Committee of Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement recommends that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors direct the Iowa County Clerk of Circuit Court to charge a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) for establishing and monitoring a payment plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that it directs Iowa County Clerk of Circuit Court to charge a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) for establishing and monitoring a payment plan effective April 1, 2006.


