

Resolution No. 3-0606

WHEREAS, Iowa County, Wisconsin is required to adopt ordinances to regulate land uses and development within floodplain and shoreland areas of the county per Chapters 59.69, 59.692, 59.694, 87.30 and 144.26 Wisconsin Statutes;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned statutes and Wisconsin Administrative Code establish standards to which certain types of development must follow;

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Office of Planning & Development (OPD) has been charged with enforcing the Iowa County Floodplain Ordinance and Iowa County Shoreland Ordinance which establish a permitting system for assuring compliance with the required standards;

WHEREAS, there are certain practices conducted within the floodplain and shoreland areas that the Iowa County Land Conservation Department (LCD) is party to designing and installing which are not exempt from the required state standards, thus requiring county permits;

WHEREAS, it is the interest of both offices to streamline the permitting process as much as possible without negating compliance with the required standards and have agreed to a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) reviewed and approved by both respective oversight committees;


