

RESOLUTION NO. 6-1207

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the compensation paid to Iowa County employees who are not represented by collective bargaining units,

WHEREAS, the Committee has considered the need for Iowa County to provide fair and competitive compensation to part time, on-call Public Health Nurses,

WHEREAS, the Committee is acting on the recommendations of the Iowa County Health Committee,

WHEREAS, the current rate of pay for the part time Public Health Nurse position is \$21/hr. and has not been increased since the position was originally staffed in 2005,

WHEREAS, the County has a considerable investment in the training of Public Health Nurses and benefits from retaining part time Nurses for their services at vaccination clinics,

WHEREAS, the County benefits from having trained part time, on-call Nurses available for deployment at public health emergencies,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, that the rate of pay be increased from \$21/hr. to \$22/hr. for part time, on-call Public Health Nurses, effective January 1, 2008.
