

Resolution No. 2-0408

WHEREAS, there does exist the Iowa County Zoning Ordinance duly adopted by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, morals, prosperity, aesthetics and general welfare and to implement the goals and policies of the Iowa County Comprehensive Plan related to growth, development and compatibility of land uses;

WHEREAS, Section 10.0 of said ordinance does create the Iowa County Board of Adjustment as authorized by Chapter 59.694 WI Stats;

WHEREAS, recent enactment of state law requires that any such board have at least two alternative members in addition to the regular members;

WHEREAS, in order to minimize costs to the county as well as the challenge of recruiting, training and keeping five full members plus two alternates, the Iowa County Planning and Zoning Commission is recommending that the Iowa County Board of Adjustment be reduced to three full members plus two alternates;

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Planning and Zoning Commission has held public meetings in addition to a public hearing on March 19, 2008 to consider this recommendation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby amends the first two sentences of Section "10.1 Establishment", page 39, as follows:

The Board of Adjustment shall consist of three (3) members to be appointed by the Chairman of the County Board of Supervisors with the approval of the County Board to include two (2) alternates as required by Sec. 59.694(2)(am)m Wis. Statutes. The terms of the members so appointed shall be for 1, 2, and 3 years, respectively.
