

Resolution No. 8-0808

WHEREAS, there is an adopted Iowa County Sanitary Ordinance as required by §59.70(1), 59.70(5), 145.04, 145.19, 145.20, and 245 Wisconsin Statutes and Wisconsin Administrative Code Comm 83;

WHEREAS, the state Department of Natural Resources and Department of Commerce are authorized to collect a groundwater protection surcharge as part of county sanitary permit fees;

WHEREAS, this state surcharge is expected to increase for 2009 to \$100 and is currently included in Iowa County Resolution 12-1206 as a flat \$75 fee;

WHEREAS, the Economic Development, Extension and Property Committee is in agreement with the Office of Planning & Development to continue the practice of passing along this state surcharge fee to the applicant in its entirety and thereby recommends adoption of this resolution stating such;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Office of Planning & Development to assess the state groundwater protection surcharge in its entirety to the applicant of an associated sanitary permit.
